B. Internationalization as an institutional priority

– *Importance of internationalization*

An overwhelming majority of institutions (more than 90%) have internationalization mentioned in their mission/strategic plan – a clear sign of how internationalization has become widespread at HEIs around the world.

– *Internationalization activities*

In terms of activities, student mobility as a whole, be it incoming or outgoing, credit or degree mobility, is the top priority in all regions, followed by strategic partnerships and international research collaboration.

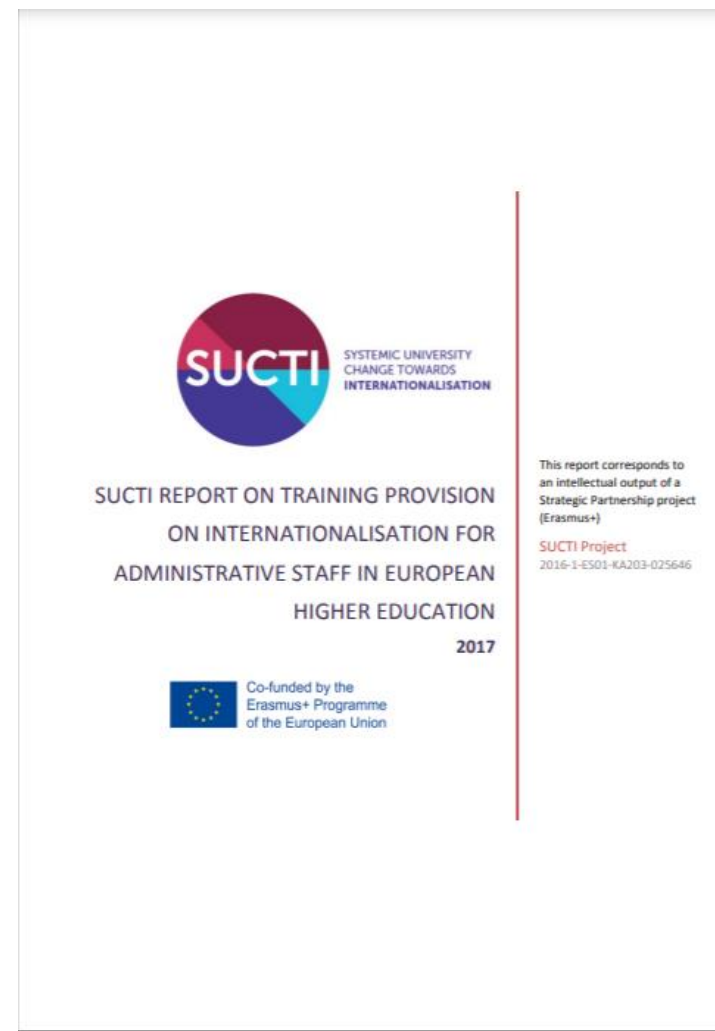
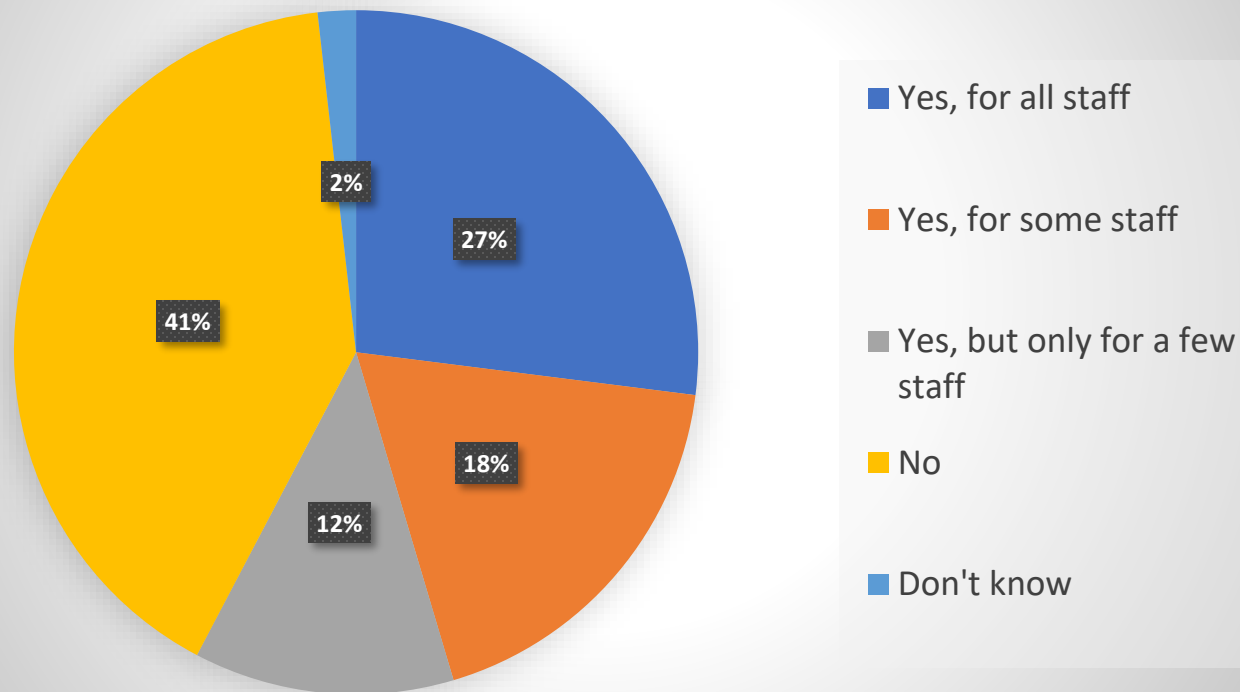


Figure 1. Training provision on internationalization for academic staff in European higher education (Source: SUCTI report, 2017)

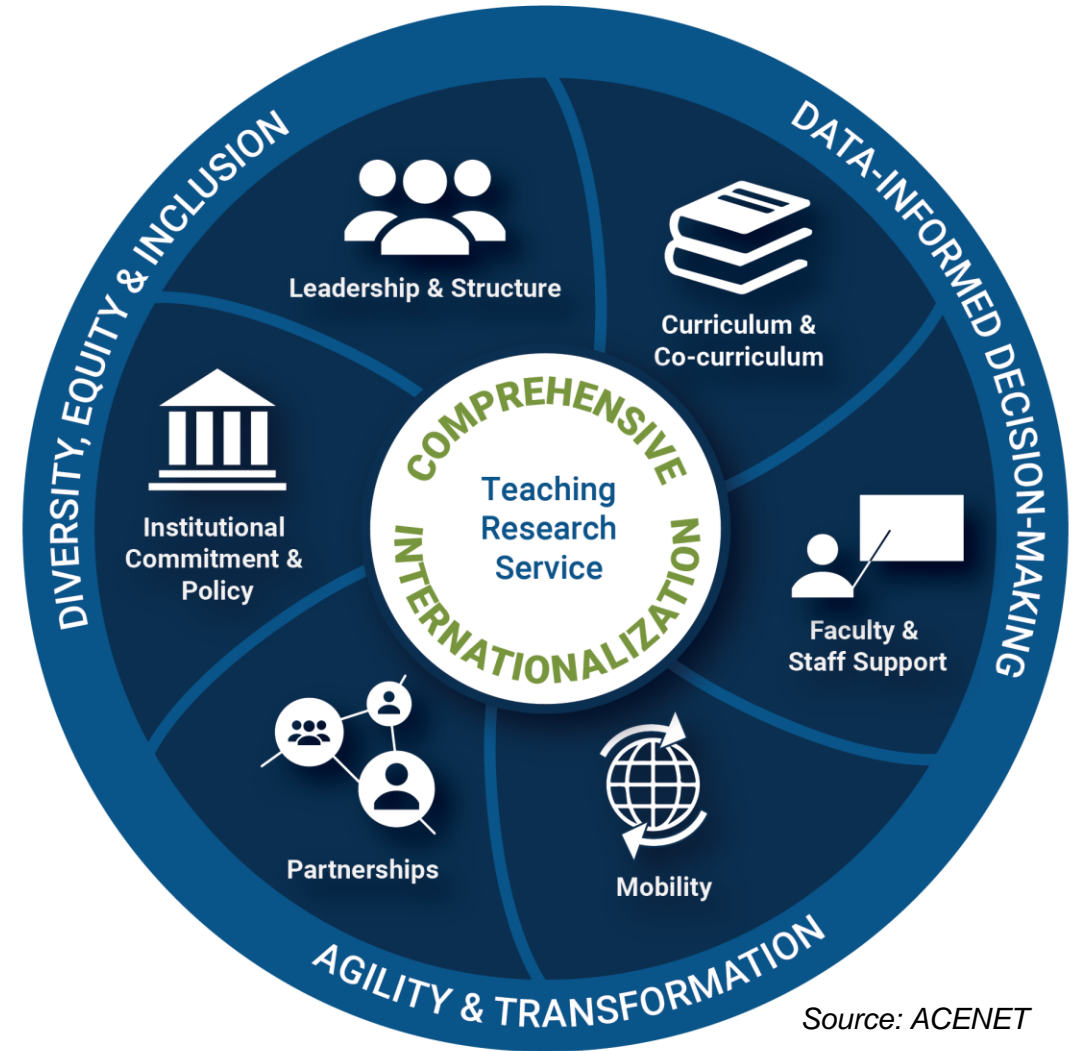

ACE Model for Comprehensive Internationalization

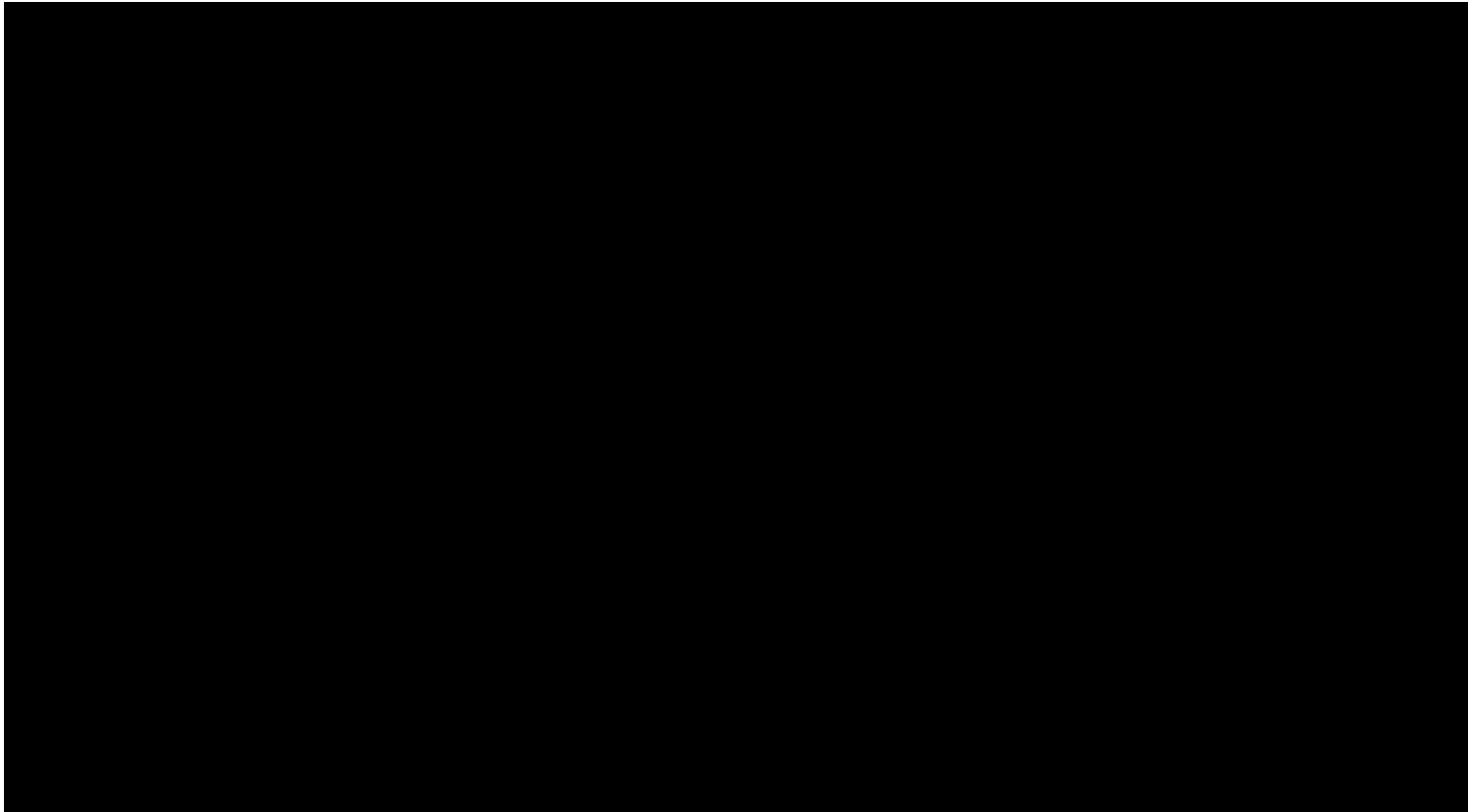

Critical analysis of UCUGO project

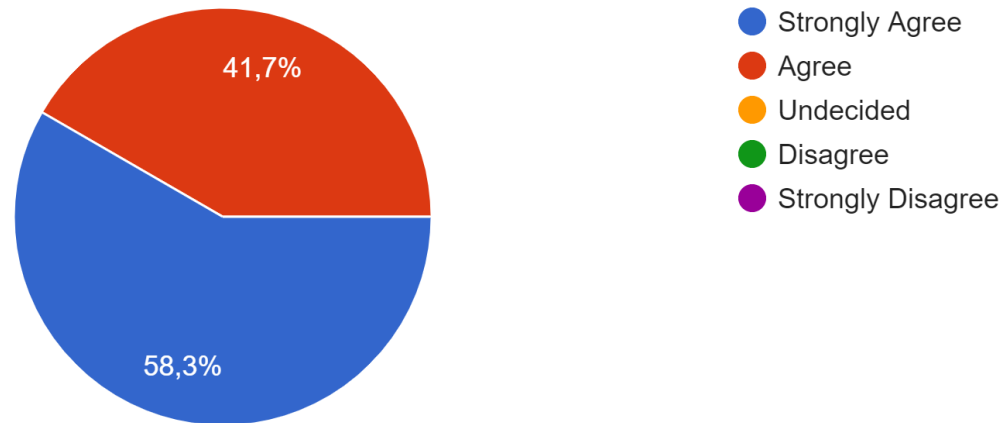
1. Effective international teamwork throughout the project planning and implementation stages → developing cooperation and trust
2. International project format and careful selection of participants → ready-to-collaborate duet match → strong focus on project goals (joint co-teaching projects in different formats)
3. Dynamic discussions on relevant topics with international experts → active participation and provoked interest to embody international and intercultural learning into their courses
4. Ice-breaking activities related to project assignments → developing trust and collaboration spirit → practicing global learning tools in multinational classroom
5. Individual trajectory/support & work in groups → 3 pairs teaching are formed after the Module 1
