- **SUPPORT** reforms in Ukrainian science

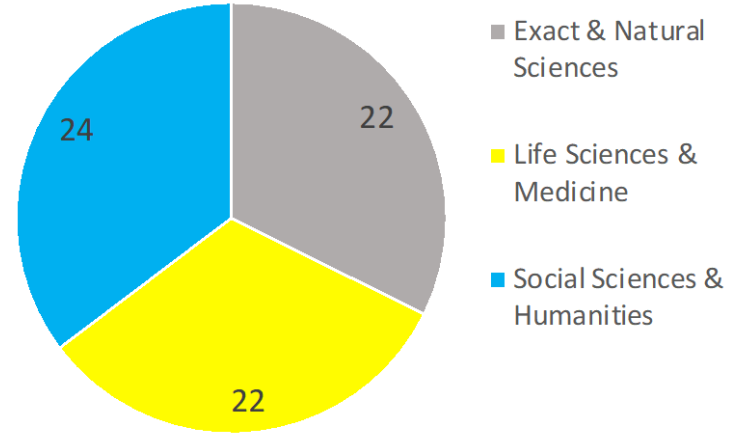
## The German-Ukrainian Academic Society/ Die Deutsch-Ukrainische Akademische Gesellschaft

- PhD students, regardless of nationality, whose topic of research relates to Ukraine





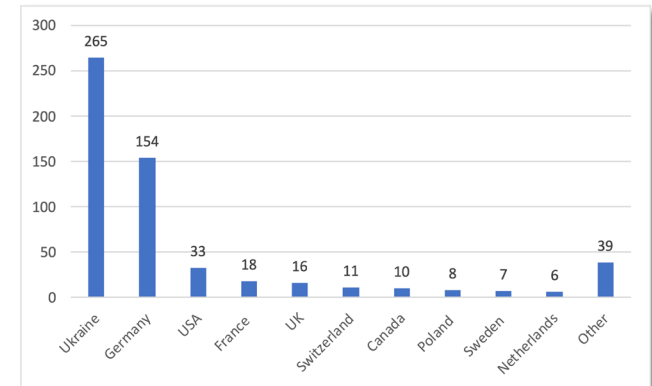
